



Gill Family Aquatic Center Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How long is the pool open and what are the pool hours?

A: The pool opens Memorial Day weekend and closes when Danville Schools are back in session. Operational hours are Monday-Saturday 11am-7pm. 12pm-7pm on Sunday.

Q: How much is it to get into the pool?

A: You will need to go to www.danvilleindiana.org/parks click on facilities then Gill Family Aquatic Center for the most accurate rate details.

Q: Is Smoking allowed at the Aquatic Center?

A: No Smoking, vaping, or any tobacco products are permitted in the Aquatic Center. None of these products are to be used within 25 feet of the Aquatic Center perimeter.

Q: Are coolers allowed in the Aquatic Center?

A: Coolers are allowed in the Aquatic Center. However all food and drink should remain up on the top deck by the concession stand. Glass containers are not allowed. ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE AQUATIC CENTER!

Q: What age does my child have to be to go to the Aquatic Center?

A: Children 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Children 8 and under must be SUPERVISED by someone 16 or older.

Q: Is there any clothing unacceptable at the Aquatic Center?

A: We are a family friendly facility. All swimsuits must be in good taste. Swimsuits showing excessive skin may not be permitted. Street clothing is not permitted in the water except for a t-shirt over their swimsuit to protect from sunburn. NO CUTOFFS ALLOWED; all shorts must be hemmed.

Q: Is there Wifi at the Aquatic Center?

A: Yes, there is Free Wifi at the Aquatic Center.

Q: What is the Aquatic Centers severe weather policy?

A: If severe weather conditions exist, we will temporarily close for 30 minutes after the severe weather passes. NO REFUNDS ARE GIVEN FOR EARLY CLOSURE! Please check the weather prior to attending. All visible lightning strikes cause a thirty-minute delay from the last strike.

Q: Does the Aquatic Center ever stay closed because of weather?

A: Our day is broken into two halves. If bad weather exists in the morning, we will close until 3pm. We re-evaluate at 3pm and make the call on the rest of the day. If the weather looks poor for the whole day or the temperature is below 70, we may decide to close all day. If poor weather exists and our attendance is less than 25 swimmers for an extended time, the manager may choose to close the pool. We post all closures on the Danville Parks Facebook page. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR EARLY CLOSURE!
